HARTFORD PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT SCHOLARSHIP FUND POLICY

All Hartford residents may request a scholarship for a facility or program fee when need exists. Proof of Hartford residency is required.

Scholarship Policy

- Requests made on a Scholarship Assistance Application must include proof of current annual combined household income. Please provide one of the following documents: Two Most Recent Paystubs, Unemployment or Disability Statement & Statement of Benefits.
- Scholarships are available for the following activities: All instructional classes; sports, dance, art, swimming, etc. Youth, family and adult passes to the swimming pool and ice arena All Town organized/sponsored youth sport activities Ventures camp programs (1 Session = 1 Activity)
- Scholarships are limited to one activity per individual per season (fall, winter, spring, summer)
- All scholarship requests must be submitted at least 7 business days prior to the close of registration. Scholarship requests received after registration closes will not be processed. Award letter will be processed within 7 business days of the receipt of a complete application.
- Applicants will be notified, by mail, of their scholarship award.

Scholarship recipients must bring the original award letter to the Parks & Recreation office to complete the registration & scholarship process prior to the activity registration deadline. The applicant is responsible for late fees if the registration deadline is not met. This includes the purchase of Pool Passes and Skating Passes.

The chart below is used to determine the scholarship percentage an applicant will receive.
